

RECRUITMENT OF FACULTY FOR RAVENSHAW UNIVERSITY

Announcement about shortlisting

Ravenshaw University had invited applications for faculty positions in various disciplines. The status of the applications has already been posted in the website of the University earlier. In view of large number of applications it has been decided to prepare shortlists and call only the shortlisted candidates for interview. These interviews will be held in phases. As and when for a particular discipline shortlist is prepared, it will be posted in this website. Thus the website will be updated from time to time. The candidates are accordingly requested to visit the website regularly to check about the cut-offs for shortlisting in their respective disciplines.

The shortlisting cut-offs for some of the disciplines are given below:

STATISTICS

Shortlisting for Readers: All candidates having first class in all three examinations (+2 or intermediate, Graduation and PG) with Ph.D. have been shortlisted and besides from the remaining candidates, candidates having 63% or above in the PG examination have also been shortlisted.

Shortlisting for Lecturers : Out of the eligible candidates, 2 candidates having first class in all three examinations (+2 or intermediate, Graduation and PG) with Ph.D and NET have been shortlisted. Beside out of the remaining candidates 5 candidates securing 63.23% and above marks at PG level have also been shortlisted.

PHILOSOPHY

Shortlisting for Readers : One candidate having first class in all three examinations (+2 or intermediate, Graduation and PG) with Ph.D. has been shortlisted. Besides from the remaining candidates, six candidates who have secured more than 65% and above in PG have also been shortlisted.

Shortlisting for Lecturers : Out of the eligible candidates, 12 candidates having first class in all three examinations (+2 or intermediate, Graduation and PG) with Ph.D or NET have been shortlisted. Beside out of the remaining candidates 2 candidates securing 71.7% and above marks at PG level have also been shortlisted.

HINDI

Shortlisting for Professors : All seven candidates with OK status have been shortlisted.

Shortlisting for Readers : One candidate having first class in all three examinations (+2 or intermediate, Graduation and PG) with Ph.D. has been shortlisted. Besides from the remaining candidates, six candidates who have secured 61.5% or above have also been shortlisted.

Shortlisting for Lecturers : All 12 candidates having first class in all three examinations (+ 2 or, Intermediate, Graduation and PG) having Ph.D. or net have been shortlisted. Besides from the remaining candidates, two candidates securing 71% or above have also been shortlisted.

PSYCHOLOGY

Shortlisting for Professors : Candidates (4 nos.) with OK status have been shortlisted.

Shortlisting for Readers : All OK 11 candidates having first class in all three examinations (+2 or intermediate, Graduation and PG) with Ph.D. have been shortlisted. Besides from the remaining OK candidates , 3 candidates who have secured 61% or above in PG have also been shortlisted.

Shortlisting for Lecturers : Out of the eligible candidates, all 3 candidates having first class in all three examinations (+2 or intermediate, Graduation and PG) with Ph.D. and NET have been shortlisted. Besides out of the eligible candidates 11 candidates having first class in all the three examinations with Ph. D. have also been shortlisted.

For Reserved category (ST) no candidate found eligible.

EDUCATION

Shortlisting for Professors : Out of the eligible candidates, five candidates having first class in all three examinations (+2 or intermediate, Graduation and PG) with Ph.D have been shortlisted. Besides out of the remaining candidates two candidates securing 68.25% and above marks at PG level have also been shortlisted.

Shortlisting for Readers : Out of the eligible candidates, fourteen candidates having first class in all three examinations (+2 or intermediate, Graduation and PG) with Ph.D and with 65.3% and above marks at PG level have been shortlisted.

Shortlisting for Lecturer : Out of the eligible candidates, all seven candidates having first class in all three examinations (+2 or intermediate, Graduation and PG) with Ph.D. and NET have been shortlisted. All others are not shortlisted.

3 candidates having OK status have been shortlisted for ST category.

7 candidates having Ok status have been shortlisted for SC category.

2 candidates having Ok status have been shortlisted for PH category.

MATHEMATICS

Shortlisting for Professors : Out of the eligible candidates, two candidates having first class in all three examinations (+2 or intermediate, Graduation and PG) with Ph.D have been shortlisted. Besides out of the remaining candidates, five candidates securing 73% and above marks at PG level have also been shortlisted.

Shortlisting for Readers : Out of the eligible candidates, nine candidates having first class in all three examinations (+2 or intermediate, Graduation and PG) with Ph.D have been shortlisted.

Beside out of the remaining candidates, five candidates securing 75.5% and above marks at PG level have also been shortlisted.

Shortlisting for Lecturer : Out of the eligible candidates, two candidates having first class in all three examinations (+2 or intermediate, Graduation and PG) with Ph.D and NET have been shortlisted. Besides out of the remaining eligible candidates nine candidates having first class in all three examinations with either Ph.D or NET have been shortlisted. Out of the remaining candidates three candidates securing 78.3% or above marks at PG level have also been shortlisted.

Under SC category no candidate is found eligible.

Under ST category there is no applicant.

COMMERCE AND BUSIENSS MANAGEMENT

Shortlisting for Professors : Out of all eligible candidates, seven candidates having first class in +2, Graduation and Master's Degree Level with Ph.D have been shortlisted.

Shortlisting for Readers (Commerce) : Out of the eligible candidates, nine candidates having first class in all three examinations (+2, Degree and Masters) with Ph.D have been shortlisted. Besides, out of the remaining eligible candidates, five candidates with 65% and above marks in PG level have also shortlisted.

Shortlisting for Readers (Commerce and Business Management) : Out of all eligible candidates, seven candidates having first class in all three examinations (+2, Graduation & Master's) with Ph.D and 63.4 % and above marks have been shortlisted.

Shortlisting for Lecturer (Commerce) : Out of all the eligible candidates five candidates having first class in all three examinations (+2, Graduation and PG) and having Ph.D or NET in the relevant subjects have been shortlisted. Besides out of the remaining eligible candidates, 11 candidates having 62% or above marks in the PG examination have also been shortlisted.

No candidate under ST Reserved category has been shortlisted.

Shortlisting for Lecturer (Business Management) : Out of all the eligible candidates four candidates having first class in all three examinations (+2, Graduation and PG) and having Ph.D or NET in the relevant subjects have been shortlisted. Besides out of the remaining eligible candidates, 12 candidates having 65% or above marks in the PG examination have also been shortlisted.

ORIYA

Shortlisting for Professors : Out of the eligible candidates, seven candidates having Ph.D. and securing 65.12% and above marks at PG level have been shortlisted.

Shortlisting for Readers : Out of the eligible candidates, all four candidates having first class in all three examinations (+2, Degree and PG) with Ph.D have been shortlisted. Besides, out of the remaining candidates ten candidates securing 68% and above marks at PG level have also been shortlisted.

Shortlisting for Lecturer : Out of the eligible candidates, seven candidates having first class in all three examinations (+2 or Intermediate, Graduation and PG) with NET and Ph.D and securing 70% marks in the PG examinations have been shortlisted.

Among the ST Candidates all seven OK candidates are shortlisted. Among the SC Candidates , seven OK candidates having 64.8% or above marks in the PG examination have been shortlisted.

Among PWD four candidates having either Ph.D. or NET or both have been shortlisted.

BOTANY

Shortlisting for Professors : Out of the eligible candidates, five candidates having first class in all three examinations (+2 or intermediate, Graduation and PG) with Ph.D. have been shortlisted. Besides out of the remaining eligible candidates, three candidates securing 68.8% or above marks in the PG examination have also been shortlisted.

Shortlisting for Readers : Out of the eligible candidates, 16 candidates having first class in all three examinations (+2 or intermediate, Graduation and PG) with Ph.D. have been shortlisted. Besides out of the remaining candidates, five candidates securing 75.3% or above marks in the PG examination have also been shortlisted.

Shortlisting for Lecturer : Out of the eligible candidates, seven candidates under Unreserved Category having first class in all three examinations with NET and Ph.D. have been shortlisted. Besides out of the remaining eligible candidates, seven candidates having first class in all three examinations and Ph.D securing 69.3% or above marks in the PG examination have also been shortlisted.

No one in the reserved category has been shortlisted.

ZOOLOGY

Shortlisting for Professors : All candidates having first class in all three examinations (+2 or intermediate, Graduation and PG) with Ph.D. have been shortlisted. Besides, out of the remaining P-OK applications five candidates having 65.7% or above marks in the PG examination have also been shortlisted.

Shortlisting for Readers : All candidates having first class in all three examinations (+2 or intermediate, Graduation and PG) with Ph.D. have been shortlisted. Besides, out of the remaining R-OK applications five candidates having 70.6 or above marks in the PG examination have also been shortlisted.

Shortlisting for Lecturers : All three candidates having first class in all three examinations (+2, graduation and PG) with both Ph.D and NET have been shortlisted. Out of the remaining candidates eleven candidates have first class in all three above examinations and Ph.D. securing 63.9% or above marks in Master's level have also been shortlisted. One ST candidate who is eligible is shortlisted.

BIOTECHNOLOGY

Shortlisting for Lecturers : Out of the eligible candidates all eleven candidates having first class in all three examinations with NET or Ph.D. have been shortlisted. Besides out of the remaining eligible candidates (i.e. having Ph.D. or NET) four candidates having 74% or above marks in the PG examination have also been shortlisted.

POLITICAL SCIENCE

Shortlisting for Professors : Out of the eligible candidates, all five candidates having first class in all three examinations (+2 or intermediate, Graduation and PG) with Ph.D. have been shortlisted.

Besides out of the remaining candidates, two candidates securing 61.6% or above marks at PG level have also been shortlisted.

Shortlisting for Readers : Out of the eligible candidates, fourteen candidates having first class in all three examinations (+2 or intermediate, Graduation and PG) with Ph.D. and having 61.5% or above marks in the PG examination have been shortlisted.

Shortlisting for Lecturer : Out of the eligible candidates, all eight candidates having first class in all three examinations (+2 or intermediate, Graduation and PG) with Ph.D. have been shortlisted. Besides six candidates having first class in all three examinations and NET and having 64% or above marks in PG examination have also been shortlisted.

Three eligible candidates (i.e. having 50% or above in PG and with Ph.D or NET) in ST category have also been shortlisted.

HISTORY

Shortlisting for Lecturers : Out of the eligible candidates, all 14 candidates having first class in all three examinations (+2 or intermediate, Graduation and PG) with Ph.D. have been shortlisted. All others are not shortlisted.

For **ST** reserved category there were two candidates, both being in L-I category (i.e. neither Ph.D. nor NET). Hence they were not shortlisted.

As there was no post in SC reserved category, no one was shortlisted in this category.

Shortlisting for Professors : Out of the eligible candidates, two candidates having first class in all three examinations (+2 or intermediate, Graduation and PG) with Ph.D. have been shortlisted. Besides out of the remaining candidates, five candidates securing 59% or above marks at PG level have also been shortlisted.

Shortlisting for Readers : Out of the eligible candidates, fourteen candidates having first class in all three examinations (+2 or intermediate, Graduation and PG) with Ph.D. and having 61.5% and above marks at PG level have been shortlisted.

CHEMISTRY

Shortlisting for Lecturers : Out of the eligible candidates, all 21 candidates having first class in all three examinations (+2 or intermediate, Graduation and PG) with Ph.D. and NET have been shortlisted. Besides out of the remaining eligible candidates, four candidates having first class in all the three examinations(+2 or intermediate, Graduation and PG) with Ph.D. and securing 70.4% or above marks in the PG examination have also been shortlisted under UR-Women Category.

In SEBC reserved category all seven candidates having first class in all three examinations (+2 or intermediate, Graduation and PG) with either Ph.D or NET or both have been shortlisted.

In SC reserved category all four candidates with either Ph.D or NET or both have been shortlisted.

Shortlisting for Professors: All six candidates having first class in all three examinations (+2 or intermediate, Graduation and PG) with Ph.D. have been shortlisted. Besides, out of the remaining P-OK applications only one candidate having 75.1% marks in the PG examination has also been shortlisted.

Shortlisting for Readers: All Twenty eight candidates having first class in all three examinations (+2 or intermediate, Graduation and PG) with Ph.D. and having 67.2% or above marks in the PG examination have been shortlisted.

PHYSICS

Shortlisting for Lecturers : Out of the eligible candidates, 14 candidates having first class in all three examinations (+2 or intermediate, Graduation and PG) and having both NET and Ph.D. and securing 63.4% and above marks in PG examination have been shortlisted. No other candidate in unreserved category is shortlisted.

Only one candidate fulfilling the eligibility criteria from the SC category has been shortlisted.

Shortlisting for Professors : Seven candidates having first class in all three examinations (+2 or intermediate, Graduation and PG) with Ph.D., and 70.5% and above marks at PG level have been shortlisted.

Shortlisting for Readers : Twenty one candidates having first class in all three examinations (+2 or intermediate, Graduation and PG) with Ph.D. and 66.7% and above marks at PG level have been shortlisted.

ENGLISH

Shortlisting for Lecturers: Out of the eligible candidates, all candidates under Unreserved Category having first class in all three examinations with NET or Ph.D. have been shortlisted. Besides, out of the remaining eligible candidates, candidates securing 61.5% or above marks in the PG examination have also been shortlisted. Besides, out of the remaining eligible candidates, women candidates securing 59% or above marks in PG examination under Unreserved Women category have also been shortlisted.

The only one SC candidate with OK status in Reserved Category is shortlisted.

Note: For appointment as Lecturer in English the relevant Postgraduate qualification is MA in English. Therefore, MA in Linguistics is not considered as eligible.

Shortlisting for Professor: One candidate having first class in all three examinations (+2 or intermediate, Graduation and PG) with Ph.D. has been shortlisted. Besides, out of the remaining candidates, six candidates securing 56.25% or above marks at PG level have also been shortlisted.

Shortlisting for Readers: Five candidates having first class in all three examinations (+2 or intermediate, Graduation and PG) with Ph.D. have been shortlisted. Besides out of the remaining candidates, twenty three candidates securing 58.6% or above marks at PG level have also been shortlisted.

ECONOMICS

Shortlisting for Lecturers: Out of the eligible candidates all ten candidates under Unreserved Category having first class in all three examinations (+2 or intermediate, Graduation and PG) with Ph.D. have been shortlisted. Besides four candidates with first class in all three examinations and NET and having 80.37% in PG examination have also been shortlisted. Besides, out of the eligible candidates, Six candidates having first class in all three examinations and NET and securing above 67% marks in the PG examination have also been shortlisted under Unreserved Women category.

Besides all the five persons who are eligible in the Reserved Category are also shortlisted.

Shortlisting for Professor: Out of the eligible candidates, candidates having first class in all three examinations (+2 or intermediate, Graduation and PG) with Ph.D. have been shortlisted. Besides out of the

remaining candidates, four candidates securing 62.3% and above marks at PG level have also been shortlisted.

Shortlisting for Readers: Out of the eligible candidates, fourteen candidates having first class in all three examinations (+2 or intermediate, Graduation and PG) with Ph.D have been shortlisted. Besides out of the remaining candidates, fourteen candidates securing 63.5% and above marks at PG level and with Ph.D have also been shortlisted.

GEOLOGY

Shortlisting for Lecturers: Out of the eligible candidates, all ten candidates having first class in all three examinations (+2 or intermediate, Graduation and PG) with Ph.D. have been shortlisted. Besides out of the remaining eligible candidates, four candidates having first class in all the three examinations with NET and securing 82.4% or above marks in the PG examination have also been shortlisted.

Shortlisting for Professor: All candidates having ten years of PG teaching/research/research guidance experience with Ph. D. have been shortlisted.

Shortlisting for Readers: All candidates having five years teaching/research experience and Ph.D. with uniformly first class in three examinations (+2, Graduation and PG) have been shortlisted. Besides, all those candidates who do not have uniformly first class in three examinations but are eligible and have Ph.D. and have secured above 62% marks have also been shortlisted.

SOCIOLOGY

Shortlisting for Lecturers: Out of the eligible candidates, nine candidates having first class in all three examinations (+2 or intermediate, Graduation and PG) with NET and Ph.D. have been shortlisted. Besides, five candidates having first class in all the three examinations, Ph.D and securing 69% or above marks in the PG examination have also been shortlisted.

Shortlisting for Professor: All six candidates with OK status have been shortlisted.

Shortlisting for Readers: All candidates having first class in all three examinations (+2 or intermediate, Graduation and PG) with Ph.D. have been shortlisted. Besides, from the remaining eligible candidates, three candidates who have Ph.D and have secured 66% or above marks in PG examination have also been shortlisted.
